- Communicate to the employees and contractors of GT's the Environmental Protection Policy, Objectives and Targets.
- Investigate all environmentally hazardous situations and occurrences.
- Correct any environmental damage caused by our operations, employees or contractors.

Employees and contractors will:

- Comply with all federal, provincial and local government regulations.
- Report all environmental occurrences caused by our operations, employees and contractors.
- Suggest potential improvements to our operation to lessen the environmental effects that we create.
- Strive to meet objectives and targets as set out by management.
- Refuse to do work that does not meet government regulations or meet the standards as set out by GT's.

All employees, contractors and sub contractors of GT's will be held accountable for their actions and those individuals who knowingly violate governmental regulations or standards set out by GT's may face disciplinary action, dismissal or legal action.
